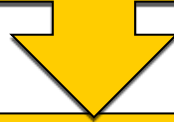

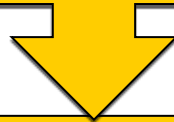

What is the BEAP

- The BEAP is a template building emergency plan
- Everything may not apply to your building
- One of the goals of the BEAP is to align all buildings throughout campus

What does the BEAP accomplish?

- Suggest response actions that individuals should consider
- Provides emergency equipment locations
- Provides information to Emergency Management for mitigation, planning, and response efforts

Why is the BEAP important?

- Provides critical information to individuals
- Assists the response efforts

What information do you need to complete the BEAP?

- Location of emergency equip and first-aid kits
- List of Area/Floor Coordinators if applicable
- Unique emergency procedures that are relevant to the building/departments.

BEAP Updates

- Transitioning from a Word document to a website form-based system.
- Bi-annual update required in the system and all other updates are as needed.
- Annual review is recommended for all staff
 - Units should review with new employees

What to expect in the coming month

- An email from emergency management staff reaching out for training within the new software
- BEAPs already submitted and fully processed from 2024-present
- Individuals who have not completed already will get a link

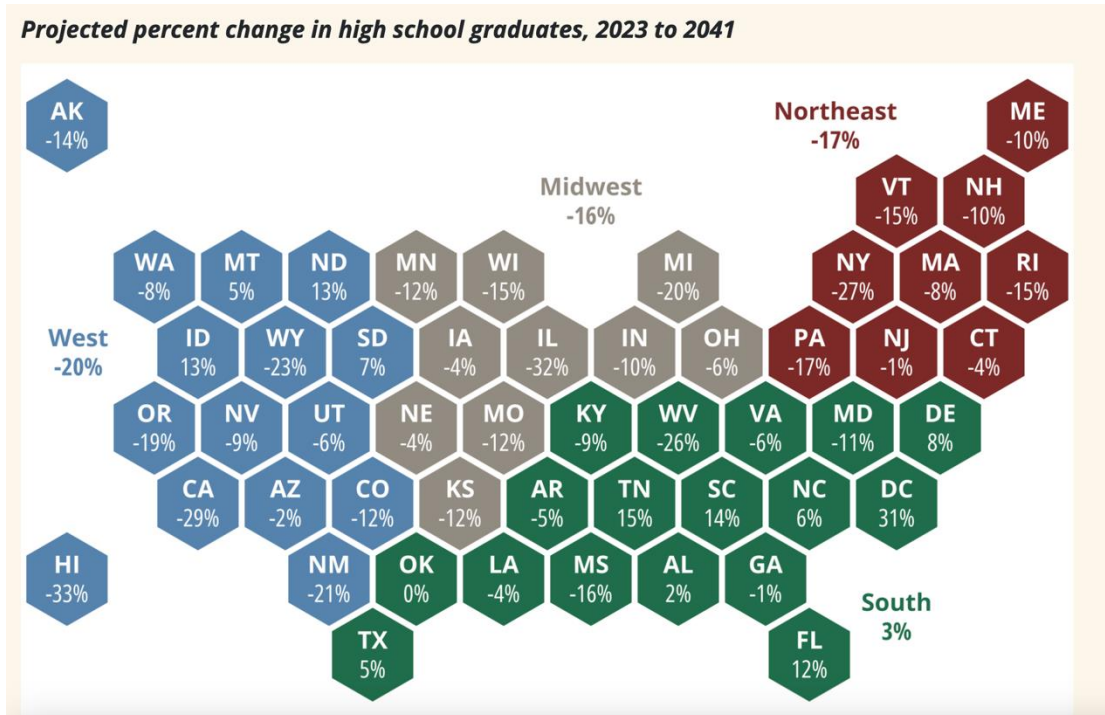
